

# Wolsey Lodges Garden Trail

[Dowthorpe Hall](#), Hull, East Yorkshire



Dowthorpe Hall comprises three and a half acres of formal and informal gardens.

Caroline Holtby has designed large, curved and colourful herbaceous borders, a large pond with an ornamental bridge surrounded by bog planting (at its best in May and June) Mediterranean planting round the swimming pool and spectacular shrub borders with a framework of mature trees. There is a vegetable garden made into a potager and an extensive orchard, all of which provide home-grown produce for the Bed and Breakfast guests. Huge pots of agapanthus surround the house and a stag presides over the fern and hosta area.

The garden is open under the National Gardens Scheme and for many artists and clubs who enjoy visiting the garden in its prime. Do stay, have dinner and savour the garden all to yourself!
