

Wolsey Lodges Garden Trail

[The Grove](#), Bath, Somerset



Surrounded by woods containing badgers, owls and deer, the garden contains a wide variety of local and tropical flora and fauna as well as topiary. There is a croquet lawn, pond and a recently discovered underground room thought to be the original Georgian icehouse. There are a variety of short and long walks nearby offering magnificent views over Bath and its surrounding countryside.

Visitors have often been surprised and delighted by the Italiante Garden, which is amazingly secluded and tranquil for a city garden. The only sound you'll hear at night here is the toot of an owl or the scampering of a badger!

The Grove's own Sculpture Garden, once part of the old pleasure gardens which adjoined the Jacobean Bath Spa is open to guests throughout the year and to the public once a year.
