This ivy-clad Tudor manor house dating from c1570, set amidst two acres of garden on the edge of the pretty village of Kirklington, is an ideal base for exploring the beautiful Yorkshire Dales.

The main reception room features a low beamed ceiling, a cosy wood burning stove, a full size billiard table and a grand piano along with comfortable chairs for evening relaxation after a day out in the Dales. The large bedrooms have ornate ceilings, carved oak panelling and views over the gardens and are beautifully decorated and furnished with comfortable chairs or sofas, Persian rugs on the oak floors and each has a luxurious en suite bathroom. The second bedroom also has its own sitting room and both bedrooms have televisions and tea making facilities. Children of all ages are welcome and extra beds are provided for them.
