Continue through Newby Bridge for a further 2 miles (passing the Lakeside and Haverthwaite Steam Railway) and turn right at the crossroads signposted to Bouth, Grizedale and Rusland. Turn right at the next T junction (300 yards) and follow the signs to Rusland (3 miles). Turn left at the junction signposted to Oxen Park and Ulverston and Cinder Hill is immediately on the right.
