The approach is down a long tree lined avenue leading to a circular driveway in front of the house. Letham House, set in 10 acres of parkland on the outskirts of Haddington, offers peace and tranquillity amidst mature trees, shrubs and a sun-drenched terrace ablaze with flowers.
