

WOLSEY LODGES

Tullibole Castle

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The turrets on the entrance tower of this Grade A listed Scottish castle with peacocks gracing sweeping lawns, are magically revealed after a winding drive through woodland.

Completed in 1608, the Moncreiff family have lived here since 1747 and yet their colourful ancestry and the 17th century architectural features do not overpower this lovely family home. Guests use the Great Hall with its enormous log fire and family portraits on the first floor as their own sitting room, reached by a winding stone spiral staircase. The generous size comfortable Georgian bedroom is next door with more stone steps leading down to a newly refurbished private bathroom.

Outside, two historic ruins - a 9th century Celtic graveyard and remnants of a ruined medieval church - and a 150 yard 'moat' and doocot sit in parkland. The one acre kitchen garden is also being restored to provide some seasonal vegetables.

Your Hosts

Rhoderick and Alison are dedicated to the Castle, the 260 acre estate and their many welcome guests. Rhoderick is Lieutenant to the Chief of the Moncreiff Clan. He and Alison are collecting family history, re-establishing the Castle Library and have published a local history book.

The Location

Most of Scotland's major attractions are less than one hour's drive away as are Glasgow, Stirling, Perth, St. Andrews and Edinburgh with its Festival, Tattoo and Highland Show. Loch Leven Nature Reserve with bird watching and trout fishing is on the doorstep as well as lots of pleasant walks.

Finding Us

M90 Junction 6 (Kinross) c5 miles west along A977, just before Crook of Devon left along B9097 for one mile, drive on left through two stone pillars set back from road. Nearest airport Edinburgh, most convenient station Inverkeithing.
